

Lainey's music reflects her ever-changing inspirations, leaning into a fresh pop universe while keeping her indie roots. Several of her recent tracks have been heard on over 40 national radio stations and on national television shows such as MTV's Teen Mom and Amazon Prime's Making The Cut. Songs "Senti(mental)" and "Wake Up Call" off of her album "Self Titled" are both semifinalists in the 2022 Unsigned Only Competition, from which she was a finalist ("I Love You To Death") and semifinalist ("Skin") in 2021, and won in 2020 for her debut single "Hey London". "Hey London" was also 3rd place AC in the 2020 International Songwriting Competition. Lainey was nominated in 5 categories of the 2021 New England Music Awards including Song of the Year, Songwriter of the Year, Female Performer of the Year, Pop Act of the Year, and won Best in the State of Rhode Island. Lainey holds the two time 2nd Place Overall Grand Prize winner title in the New England Songwriting Competition following her 2019 win. Also in 2019, she was a placing finalist in Rhode Island's Summer's End Race to the Stage Competition. In 2018, Lainey was nominated for Best Solo/Acoustic Act, Best Americana Act, and Best College Act at the Worcester Music Awards, along with Best Breakthrough Act at Rhode Island's famed, Motif Music Awards.

Before breaking into the pop scene, Lainey released her debut record, Can't Refuse-EP, in

2016. The EP is a collection of original indie folk songs that were featured on HomeBru'd, a

segment for New England's leading alternative radio station, WBRU at the time. Her song

titled "The Next Move" off of the EP was a 2016 semifinalist for the International Songwriting

Competition. After the release, Lainey and her band toured the East Coast in the summer of

2017 debuting new material along with the EP. As a performing artist, Lainey has been invited

to play at famed music venues such as The Strand, regional festivals such as The Big E, and

over 90 venues in Rhode Island. Lainey has opened for renowned artists such as Drake Bell,

The Head and The Heart, Chase Rice, and Ronny Cox.

Lainey graduated Magna Cum Laude from Berklee College of Music in 2015, receiving her

Bachelor's Degree in Music Business with a minor in Music Production and Engineering. While

attending, she had the pleasure of learning from industry professionals such as Grammy

Award winning producer, Jason Stokes and Grammy-nominated hit songwriter, producer,

and Warner Brothers Records executive, Kara DioGuardi. She was also accepted into former

Warner/Chappell Publishing Group executive Judy Stakee's Songwriting Retreat in France.

Lainey is currently working on her sophomore full length album.
